

DELIVERANCE THROUGH THE PASSOVER

Exodus 11 - 12

After each plague, Pharaoh promised to let Israel go and serve God; but each time when the punishment was removed, he changed his mind and refused to let them go. Now see what happened when the ninth plague was ended:

A. Pharaoh's Final Answer to God: Read Exodus 10:28, 29

2. What did he threaten to do if Moses did not obey? Exodus 10:28b

3. What sin do you think Pharaoh was guilty of committing? (*THINK!*)

2. What did he predict would happen? Exodus 11:5

5. What would happen as a result of this plague? Exodus 11:8, 1

1. What were three requirements for the lamb to be used in this feast?
